Enlisted Ranks And Promotion Guide

The Enlisted Boot Camp Or Rifleman Training Is The Hardest Part Of Part Of Enlisted Members Time. The Enlisted Troops Will Start Easy And Move Up To More Challenging Tests And Skills Required To Receive A Promotion To The Next Rank. All Enlisted Members Must First Visit D14 And Have, At The Minimum A Rifle Above 200 FPS And Electrically Powered. As The Member Moves On They Must Have A 300+ FPS Rifle And Pistol Before They Become A Sergeant, Failure To Have The Right Equipment May Result In A Temporary Stand-Still In The Ranking Process. It Is Also Required That Before The Recruit Becomes a Private First Class That They Have Urban ACU And Multicam ACU If The Recruit Can Not Afford Or Can't Find The Correct Uniform It Is Important That The Recruit Contacts Recruiting And Military Outreach Department For Assistance. It Is Also Requested

Than Any Rifle That Does Not Fit And American Loadout First Be Approved By A Colonel Or Lieutenant Colonel. The American Loadout Consists Of M4 Style Rifles, SCAR L-H, AR 15, Glock Brand, If The Rifle The Recruit Has Does Not Match With What Is Listed Above A Colonel Or Lieutenant Colonel May Approve The Rifle For Use Until The Recruit Buys A New Rifle, Furthermore If The Colonel Of Trepidations Want's To Officially Approve A Rifle He May, Given The Power By Withholding The Rank Of Colonel. However, If The Rifle Is Not Approved The Recruit Is Given 12 Months To Buy A New Rifle, If The Recruit Can Not Afford Or He Is Not Willing To Purchase A New One, The Recruit Will Be Placed In A Special Division Of Trepidations, This Team Will Consist Of People That Can Not Afford To Purchase The Correct Uniform/Rifle. (If Recruits Refuse After 12 Months They Will Be Discharged From Trepidations.) After Basic Rifleman Training The Recruit May Be Placed On A Probationary Period With Major Jonathan A. Of 1st Infantry Division If The General's Incharge Of The Team Feel As If The Recruit Performed As Good As

A Member Of The Elite Team, They Can Directly Transfer And Remove Your Probation Period. However If The Recruit Performs To The Standard They Will Stay Or Move Out Of Charlie Team And Transfer To Our Main Division If The Generals Feel As If You Perform Better. Then The Soldier Will Be Moved To The Most Elite Division, The Last Division.

-----CURRENT PROMOTION GUIDE FOR ENLISTED-----

E1- Must go through Basic Rifleman Training

E2- Attend Two D14 Games

E3- Attend A Combat Training And Pass With A 70%

E4- Must Attend Advanced Rifleman Training

E5- Must Apply To; And Pass NCO's School

E6- Must Demonstrate The Ability To Perform And Apply Basic Leadership Skills

E7- Must Demonstrate The Ability To Secure And Inspect Uniforms And Gear Before Deployment

E8- Must Be Able To Use All Skills Taught To Command A Team

After Passing Officer Candidate School The Member Must Be Able To Apply What Has Been Taught To Take Second Command Of A Squad. After The Skills Have Been Mastered And Proven, The Candidate Will Have Successfully Graduated Officer Candidate School (OCS). OCS Can Have ONLY 5 Member Actively Attempting To Pass And Move On Into Officer Ranks. The Officer Candidate School Can Choose Who To Pass And Who To Fail. And The Candidate May Retake The OCS After 2 Weeks. Honor Grads Are Allowed, However If The Candidate Is Not Seen Fit By The TECOT Department General, He/She Holds All Power To Withdraw The Honor Graduate From His/Her Position With Reasonable Doubt That The Testing Was Unfair Or Rigged In The Honor Graduate's Favour. The TECOT Department General Does NOT Hold The Power To Revoke A Honor Grad's Promotion After 48 Hours Of The Graduates Promotional Period.
